## LESSON 6 THE ROOTS -POLIS- AND -URB-



The roots -polis- (and its related form -polit-) and -urb- derive from two ancient words for "city." Polis was the ancient Greek word for city-state, that is, a self-governing city such as Athens or Sparta. Urbs was the Latin word for city. Both polis and urbs have been sources for many newer words in English, ten of which you will learn in this lesson.
